(4) Procedure - Are all the materials mentioned in the procedure?	5	
(5) Procedure - Is the project replicable?	5	
(6) Data Collection - Is the data displayed using the best format for the project (i.e., graph, chart, drawing, etc.)? Are the correct parameters displayed in the data? Does the data support the procedures? (5 points for each question)	15	
(7) Valid Conclusion: Does the conclusion reflect the data? Does the conclusion link back to the problem formulation? (5 points for each question)	10	
(8) The Interview - How well does the scholar articulate knowledge of the topic?	20	
(9) The Interview - Can the scholar suggest additional projects or experiments that would expand the findings of this project?	5	
(10) The Poster Project Report: Does the report contain the information on the poster?	10
